## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. A trophy and/or cash and ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated. Championship and reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions.
2. Judges decisions are final.
3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide the classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
4. Prize money will be deducted from the total entry fees, any prize money in excess of the total entries will be paid in the form of a check within 30 days of the close of the competition.
5. \$500 Handy Hunter classes will offer 50% of stated money if less than six entries.
6. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.
7. Every class offered herein which is cover by the Rules & Specifications of the current State Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
8. Entry Fee: \$30.00 per class unless otherwise stated.
9. Indoor Arena 100 x 200 with a well groomed sand based footing. Outdoor Warm—Up with a stone dust and sand footing.
10. Post Entries accepted the day of the show.
11. Competition management shall piece a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up too \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
12. All dogs must be leashed.
